Participant Guidelines & Code of Conduct

TechnoXian World Cup 9.0

Event Dates: 30th August – 2nd September 2025 **Venue:** Noida Stadium Complex, Uttar Pradesh, India

1. General Information

- All participants must **register online** and collect their **physical ID Pass** at the registration counter upon arrival.
- Entry without a valid TechnoXian 9.0 Participant Pass is strictly prohibited at arena
- Participants must attend all briefings, matches, and scheduled ceremonies unless officially excused.
- Teams should ensure timely arrival at the venue and adhere to the **daily schedule** published on the TechnoXian mobile app and website.
- Download the TechnoXian App (Android/iOS) to access:
 - o Competition schedule & arena location
 - o Team slot and game turn notifications
 - o Real-time announcements & emergency alerts
 - o Maps, help desk contacts, and live result updates

2. Team Photo, Logo & Social Media Engagement

- All participating clubs/teams must submit the following by 20th August 2025:
 - High-resolution team photograph (in Group)
 - Club/School/Institution logo in PNG or vector format
- Files should be uploaded via the TechnoXian App or submitted by email to support@technoxian.com

Social Media Update

- Teams are encouraged to:
 - Promote their journey and participation on platforms like Instagram, X (Twitter),
 Facebook, YouTube, and LinkedIn
 - Use the official hashtag #TechnoXian and #WORSO
 - Tag @TechnoXian in all posts, reels, and stories
- Selected posts will be **featured on official TechnoXian handles and at the venue screens** during the event

3. Dress Code Guidelines

Inaugural Ceremony (30th August, 5:00-8:00 PM)

- All participants must wear:
 - o **Team Uniform / Tracksuit** with national or club insignia/logo. School uniform is not allowed
 - Matching sports shoes (preferably white or black).
 - o Teams must carry their country's or club's flag during the procession.
- No casual clothing or slippers/sandals will be permitted on stage or during procession.

Competition Days (31st Aug – 2nd Sept)

- During matches or technical rounds:
 - o Participants should wear team/club uniform (Only sports) or TechnoXian T-Shirts.
 - o Maintain a **neat and disciplined appearance** in the arena.
- Dress changes, if needed, must be done in designated areas only.

4. Opening Procession & Decorum

- All teams must report to the assembly area by 3:30 PM on 30th August for formation.
- Every country/club must:
 - Carry 1 Country/club flag of 8X6 feet
 - Nominate one flag bearer
 - Walk in a single file procession in designated sequence
- No loud cheering, dancing, or waving of commercial banners will be permitted in the procession.
- Please maintain the dignity and spirit of the international representation.

5. Entry & Security Protocols

- Participant Passes must be worn at all times for entry into arenas, lounges, and competition
 zones
- Keep the pass visible and intact. Lost passes must be reported immediately; reissuance may incur a fee.
- No outside food, weapons, or banned electronics (like jammers, high-range Wi-Fi boosters) allowed.
- Security checks will be strict. Cooperation is expected at all gates.

6. Game Turn & Arena Protocol

- All teams must:
 - o Arrive 30 minutes before scheduled game time
 - o Check-in at the respective competition desk at the designated area
 - Follow the game referee/arena manager's instructions without argument
- Delays beyond 10 minutes may result in disqualification or shift in match order.
- Participants are not allowed to enter arenas other than their assigned competition zone.
- Technical support will be available on request at every arena.

7. Participant Conduct & Decorum

- Maintain sportsmanlike **behavior** at all times.
- Disrespect to referees, volunteers, or fellow participants will result in warning or disqualification.
- Use of vulgar language, inappropriate gestures, or unsportsmanlike tactics will not be tolerated.
- No physical altercations or sabotage will be tolerated; immediate disqualification and removal from premises.

8. Award Ceremony Protocol (2nd September, 4:00–6:00 PM)

- All finalists and winners must:
 - o Assemble at the award assembly area by 3:30 PM
 - o Follow stage entry sequence as announced
- Winners must:
 - Collect awards personally; no proxies will be entertained. Only participating team members are allowed to come on stage.
 - o Pose for official photographs
 - o Return backstage promptly after the ceremony
- National flags or team banners may be held during photographs but no commercial signs allowed on stage.
